What is a Workation?

There is no clear definition of what a workation is in the dictionaries yet. The word itself is a hybrid of the words "work" and "vacation". The main idea of a workation is to take a break from the daily routine and change the scenery while working from another location.

Workationing vs working remotely

The difference between "workationing" and working remotely is focused on the amount of time spent on a workation versus working remotely.



A remote employee is working entirely offsite, usually at a geographically fixed location.



An employee on a workation, works remotely on a short-term trip or extends their vacation with some more working days in an attempt to explore the city further.

The increasing popularity





Many countries adapted to these changes and even adapted new visas especially designed for remote workers.

The first digital nomad village Digital Nomads Madeira was launched on February 1st 2021, on this Portuguese island and aims to attract digital nomads and people escaping for workations. The Regional Government of Madeira develops the project through Startup Madeira.
